

## PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS FOR PILGRIM PLACE RESIDENTS

There are several Transportation options – both public and private - for Pilgrim Place Residents. Use public transportation as often as possible. If you have questions, please contact a committee member for information and guidance. (See names on last page)

Please be aware that [www.maps.google.com](http://www.maps.google.com) provides information on many public transportation options from your home, with route numbers and approximate times. After you enter the addresses, click on the bus icon. In addition, visit the TRANSIT STORE located in the Claremont Depot, 200 West First Street, open 7 a.m. - 6 p.m. M-F, 10 a.m.-2 p.m. first and last Saturdays of the month, or call 1-800-743-3463 to learn more about all area public transportation services to meet your needs.

### **I. THE CLAREMONT MANOR BUS** **(Tuesdays & Thursdays only)**

The Claremont Manor Bus runs on a regular schedule, **but all times are approximate**. The bus stops on the west side of Porter Hall for pick-up and drop-off. You may wait on the Abernathy patio. (Drop-off can be at other locations as requested.)

9:15 a.m. Pick-up to Foothill Blvd

Pick-ups for return depend on the residents and the stores they are visiting. The driver can give you an approximate time for your pick-up for the return trip.

10:10 a.m. approximate return to Pilgrim Place

10:15 a.m. approximate Pick-up at Pilgrim Place for Village run.

Foothill Blvd. bus stops: Trader Joe's, U.S.Bank, Sprouts, Stater Bros., CVS, Staples. Stops in the Village: Bank of America, Wells Fargo Bank, Post Office, Hendricks Pharmacy, & other stops as requested. The fare is \$1.25 each way. You need a ticket, purchased at the Administration's front desk. Please have the exact amount in cash or check made out to Pilgrim Place.

### **II. THE CLAREMONT DIAL-A-RIDE**

**Dial-a-Ride** (and Get-About) **users must have an identification number when making a reservation. Register at (909) 621-9900.** You will receive an I.D. number at that time and may begin using the service right away. It will take one to one and a half weeks to get your I.D. card in the mail.

**To reserve a ride call 623-0183 one hour before desired pick-up time**, for curb-to-curb shared ride cab service (sometimes private). **Service is provided Mon.-Fri. 6 am to 7 pm, and Sat. 7 am to 6 pm.** The cost each way is \$0.75 (for 60+ and disabled); drivers cannot make change; please have exact fare. Dial-a-Ride also accepts Get-About tickets. (Tips are not required but appreciated.) Give exact address of your pick-up location and your destination. **YOU MUST BE READY.**

For Medical Appointments: Reservations may be made 2 hours to one day ahead of appointment. Cab most often arrives within 5 minutes of scheduled pick-up time.

For Non-Medical Appointments: Calls may only be made 45 minutes before desired pick-up. Cab will arrive within 5 to 45 minutes of scheduled time.

Wheel Chairs and other Mobility Devices: You must inform operator that you have a wheel chair/walker. (Van will arrive any time between 5 and 60 minutes of requested time.)

Returning to Pilgrim Place: Call for pick-up when you are ready to return home. The wait for return transportation is usually longer. Two riders traveling from the same pick-up address to the same location can ride for the cost of one fare.

### **III. GET-ABOUT**

**Get-About and Dial-a-Ride users must have an identification number when making a reservation. Register at (909) 621-9900;** you will receive an I.D. number at that time; it will take one to one and a half weeks to get your I.D. card. You may also go to 141 South Spring St., Claremont to register, and then purchase tickets at that time. Once registered, tickets may be purchased at the Joslyn Senior Center; discounted Ticket Books may be purchased at City Hall. Get About also accepts Claremont Dial-a-Ride tickets.

Door-to-door, ride-sharing service for seniors 60 years of age and over, and disabled persons of any age. Wheelchair accessible vehicles are available. Transportation to anywhere in Claremont, Pomona, La Verne, San Dimas, Montclair Plaza. The charge is \$1.00 each way; a book of 12 tickets is \$10.00.

**Reservations should be made one day in advance by calling 596-5964. Service is available from 6 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. (last available pick-up time) weekdays; and 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.**

**Sundays.** Same day transportation is provided space permitting. Inform the operator of the exact addresses of your pick-up and destination; if it is a doctor's appointment, give the time of your appointment; inform operator if you are in a wheelchair or use a walker. You may also schedule the time to be picked up for return home.

### **IV. METRO ACCESS**

Access Services provides door-to-door transportation throughout Los Angeles County to individuals who, because of their disabilities, are unable to use fixed route buses. It is necessary to **apply for membership and ID card 21 days in advance.** Call 1-800-827-0829. (For hearing impaired call 1-800-827-1359.)

## **V. FOOTHILL TRANSIT – 1-800-743-3463. Hearing impaired – 626-967-3147)**

Foothill Transit operates buses which pass through Claremont. Senior fare (62 and older) is \$0.50 with an additional \$0.25 for a transfer; you must buy the transfer when you pay your original fare. Transfer is valid within two hours, including return trip. You must have exact change. (Fare box will accept \$1 bill forfeiting change.) Seniors must have a photo ID; disabled must have Medicare card. Schedules and a system map are available at [foothilltransit.org](http://foothilltransit.org). Or you can call the number above or get Bus Book with detailed information from City Hall, the Claremont Depot, or on a bus. There is a Bus Book in the Transportation Folder in the Library, though it may not be the latest; an updated book is issued 3-4 times a year. Most buses run every 20-30 minutes during the day, less frequently at night and all can actually require much longer waits.

## **SILVER STREAK BUS: - 1-800-743-3463. Hearing impaired - 626-967-3147**

The Silver Streak Bus (express bus service) runs from the Montclair TransCenter to Los Angeles with stops only at Pomona TransCenter, The Plaza at West Covina, El Monte Station, Cal State LA, USC Medical Center, Union Station, and ending at Grand & Olympic in L.A. The whole trip takes approximately 1 ½ hours. Fare is \$2.75. A senior discount (\$1.35) is available off peak hours (10-2). You must have exact change and a photo ID.

## **VI. METROLINK**

Commuter train system provides service between Claremont and Union Station in downtown Los Angeles (with stops in Pomona, Covina, and El Monte) and to San Bernardino (with stops in Montclair, Upland, and Rancho Cucamonga). Those 65 and older receive a 50% discount. Fare is based on distance traveled; e. g. Claremont to Union Station costs \$4.25 each way for seniors. A “quiet car” is now available, the second passenger car behind the locomotive, to enjoy a quiet, relaxing ride.

The DASH bus provides free direct service from Union Station via several lines to all of downtown L.A. and USC. This service is FREE with your Metrolink ticket or 35 cents if you are not using Metrolink. Schedules for Metrolink trains (both weekday and weekends) and maps of DASH service are available in the Pilgrim Place Library and usually at the Transit Store in the Claremont Depot. ## **VII. TRANSPORTATION TO LAX AND ONTARIO (ONT) AIRPORTS**

- (1) The Super Shuttle offers shared door-to-door service to LAX and ONTARIO airports 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. You must prepay with credit card to make reservation to LAX, and card or cash to Ontario. For reservations, call 1-800-258-3826 or go to [www.supershuttle.com](http://www.supershuttle.com). You will need to give your airline, flight number, date and departure time. Reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance. Provide your own car seat for a child.

From your door to LAX - \$56.00 for the first person, \$9.00 for each additional person. \$2.00 discount available for AAA members.

From your door to Ontario Airport - \$21.00 for the first person, \$9.00 for each additional person.

- (2) LAX via Metrolink plus Fly-Away Bus. Metrolink to Union Station costs \$8.50 one-way or \$4.25 for seniors (65 and over). From Union Station to LAX use the “Fly-Away Bus” (\$7.00 each way, about 50 minutes).

### **VIII. TRANSPORTATION IN PRIVATE AUTOMOBILES (Volunteer drivers)**

While the committee strongly urges the use of public transportation, Pilgrim drivers are available and listed below.

#### **Pilgrim drivers do not charge, but we suggest that you contribute the following amounts:**

To LAX - **\$60.00.** To Ontario Airport - **\$15.00.** Local trips - **\$6.00.**

**(Note: If the driver takes you someplace and drops you off, then returns later to pick you up, you should consider it as two trips when leaving your gift.)**

“D” is for a driver for local transportation (shopping and appointments)

“O” is for travel to the Ontario International Airport.

“L” is for travel to the LAX International Airport.

\*Can take a light-weight walker, but not a wheelchair

\*\*Can handle a walker or a fold-up wheelchair
