Information on Donating Books to Pilgrim Place

Thank you so much for your thoughtful desire to donate books to the Pilgrim Place Library.

The Library gift policy is to accept for consideration hardcover books in good condition that have been published within the last 5 years. We also accept for consideration compact disc audio books.

Duplicates of books already in our collection are given to Pilgrim Place Used Books Sale. These books are sold during the year and at the annual Pilgrim Place Festival in November. Proceeds from these sales become a part of the important Resident Health and Support Program that aids those residents who need financial support. Pilgrim Place friends and future residents are welcome to donate books directly to the Used Book Sale by bring their books to the Festival Building, located on Mayflower Circle on the Pilgrim Place campus. Because the Pilgrim Place library space is limited and the availability for all Pilgrim Place residents to use the excellent Claremont School of Theology Library and Claremont Colleges Honnold Library, we accept few books in the field of religion or research works.

We do have both an archival collection and circulating collection of books written by residents. We would be pleased to accept one copy, and preferably two copies, of any books that Pilgrim Place residents have written. One copy is placed in the Pilgrim Place archives and the second copy is available for circulation through the Pilgrim Place Library.
