Dear Residents and Family Members,

We are informing you that an HSC staff member tested positive yesterday (Nov. 15) for the COVID-19 virus. Unfortunately, the staff member did provide direct care to some of our residents. Residents who were cared for by the individual will continue to be in quarantine for precautionary measures and family members have been notified.

We will continue to follow CDC guidelines as well as the directives from our assigned Los Angeles County Department of Public Health nurse, to ensure we are taking the appropriate steps, to limit the spread of COVID-19.

Indoor and outdoor visitations will resume. Those entering **MUST** show proof of vaccination card with bivalent or **MUST** be tested before entering.

Definition of Up to Date:

An individual is up to date with COVID-19 vaccines when they have received all recommended doses in the primary series (i.e., are fully vaccinated) and any recommended booster dose(s).

In other words, individuals falling into the following categories are up to date:

- **Completed their primary series but are not yet eligible for a booster dose, OR**
- **Received primary series AND the updated (bivalent) booster dose at least 2 months after completion of the primary series or after the last monovalent booster dose for both immunocompetent and immunocompromised individuals 12 years and older.**

Please note, as of Sep 2, 2022, there is a new booster recommendation that replaces all prior booster recommendations for individuals 12 years and older.
